October 2022

Early Intervention:

- Trena Bauder, Natalie Terrell, Stacie Easton, Miranda Johnson and I attended the State EIEP and WDE required training In Riverton, October 13 and 14, 2022. The focus was on Least Restrictive Environments and Eligibility.

Early Childhood:

- Tausha has been working to complete a CLASS Observation for all classrooms this Fall.

Early Head Start:

- The Office of Head Start has sent out letters notifying programs who will be reviewed this year. We have not received a letter, although we were expecting to be reviewed.
- The new Program Specialist, from Denver, is planning a visit for July of 2023.

Financial:

- The credit card system is still delayed, now for a contract to be signed by the Commissioners.

Personnel:

- We hired a new EHS Administrative Assistant, Kierra Bulkley, and a new Part C Early Interventionist, Diana Gonzalez. They both started on October 3rd. We are still working to recruit and hire a Speech and Language Pathologist.
